- Om 'n kundige bydra tydens Klasbesprekings te maak.

Purpose:

To offer a comprehensive Psychological service to support learners, parents and staff of Martie du Plessis.

Functions:



- To receive applications from the District Based Support Team, to assess and circulate them to all departments to reach a consensus decision.
- To arrange a scanning week in cases where there is doubt about the suitability of a candidate and act as chairman when giving feedback to parents.
- To perform 1st Assessment on admitted learners and act as chairman when giving feedback to parents.
- To act as behaviour expert during Clinical and Behaviour discussions and Disciplinary hearings and give professional guidance if necessary.
- To offer a comprehensive psychotherapeutic and guidance service to learners.
- To give parents guidance where necessary.
- To perform subject choice assessments on the Grade 9's.
- To perform Vocational Guidance on the Grade 12's
- To keep clinical and other notes.
- To liaise with other professional persons (such as medics) regarding a learner.
- To perform psychometric evaluations, where necessary.
- To make an expert contribution during class discussions.

Conditions often treated:



- Attention Deficit and Hyperactivity
- Serious Specific Learning Disability
- Mood disorders (e.g. Depressions and Anxiety)
- Behavioural problems
- Inadequate study methods
- Peer pressure
- Social adjustment
- Inability to progress scholastically

Psychometry often used:



- Cognitive measuring instruments
- Interest questionnaires
- Personality measuring
- Biographical questionnaires
- Clinical questionnaires (e.g. Beck Depression Scale)
